- The committee will scrutinize the abstracts and will inform you further for your selected Abstract for an oral presentation / poster presentation.
- Scientific paper presentation will run concurrently at a different venue.
- Original and unpublished research papers related to nursing are invited.
- The full name of all Authors should be given. Kindly bold the name of the presenting Author.
- The presenting Author should be registered for the conference.

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

- The Abstract should be in **IMRAD** format. The word count should not exceed **300 words**, and it should be sent in a **Word File**.

Abstract Structure

Title

- Concise, informative, and capitalized.
- Avoid abbreviations.

Authors and Affiliations

- List all contributing authors.
- Include institutional affiliations.
- Identify the presenting author with an asterisk (*).

Introduction / Background

- Briefly state the problem or research question.
- Highlight the significance of the study.

Objectives

- Clearly outline the purpose of the research.

Methods

- Summarize the study design, population/sample, data collection, and analysis.

Results

- Provide key findings.
- Use concise descriptions.

Conclusion

- Summarize key takeaways.
- Discuss implications for practice, policy, or future research.

Keywords

- Include **3–5 relevant keywords**.

Gandhi Ashram

Located on the banks of the Sabarmati River, this historic ashram was the residence of Mahatma Gandhi and served as a center for India's freedom movement. The ashram houses a museum displaying letters, photographs, and artifacts related to Gandhiji's life.

Sabarmati Riverfront

Indroda Nature Park

Often referred to as the “Jurassic Park of India,” this nature park features dinosaur fossil exhibits, a zoo, botanical gardens, and nature trails. It is located on the banks of the Sabarmati River and is ideal for nature lovers.

Distance: 5 km from C. M. Patel College of Nursing



The Shree Dholeswar Mahadev Temple

An ancient Hindu shrine dedicated to Lord Shiva, located on the banks of the Sabarmati River in Randesan, Gandhinagar. Often referred to as the "Kashi of Gujarat," it is believed that devotees who cannot visit Kashi (Varanasi) can earn similar spiritual merit by bathing in the Sabarmati here and offering prayers.

Distance: 6.8 km from C. M. Patel College of Nursing





SMVS Swaminarayan Mandir

A beautiful and peaceful temple dedicated to Lord Swaminarayan. Known for its stunning architecture, serene atmosphere, and well-maintained surroundings, the temple offers a spiritual and calming experience for visitors. It is an ideal place for meditation, prayer, and experiencing the cultural and religious heritage of Gujarat.

Distance: Approximately 5.7 km from C. M. Patel College of Nursing

Shri Umiya Mataji Temple

This temple in Gandhinagar is a significant spiritual and community hub for the Kadva Patidar community, dedicated to their clan deity (kuldevi), Goddess Umiya. Located in the heart of the city, the complex is known for its peaceful atmosphere and extensive social facilities.

Distance: Approximately 1 km from C. M. Patel College of Nursing



Mahatma Mandir

Located in Gandhinagar, it is one of India's largest and most modern convention and exhibition centers, integrated with a memorial dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi. Managed by The Leela, the 34-acre complex is a hub for global events like the Vibrant Gujarat Global Summit.

Distance: Approximately 2 km from C. M. Patel College of Nursing





Central Vista Garden (Swarnim Park)

Commonly known as Swarnim Park, this is a sprawling, manicured green space located in the heart of Gujarat's capital. It is popular for its serene environment and recreational facilities.

Distance: Approximately 1.3 km from C. M. Patel College of Nursing

Toy Train Park (Children's Park)

Located in Sector 28 of Gandhinagar city, this is a popular garden and tourist attraction. The amusement facilities attract children and adults alike. The lake and the mini-train are added attractions where people can practice boating and enjoy a scenic ride.

Akshardham Temple

One of Gujarat's most famous spiritual sites, dedicated to Lord Swaminarayan. The complex features stunning stone architecture, cultural exhibitions, landscaped gardens, and an evening light-and-sound show.

Vardayini Mata (or Vardayini Devi) Temple

Vardayini Devi is a form of Goddess Durga, primarily worshipped at the Shree Vardayini Mataji Temple in Rupal village, near Gandhinagar. She is considered the second form of Navdurga, known as Brahmacharini, and is revered as a wish-fulfilling deity. According to local lore, the temple was established by the Pandavas during the Mahabharata era. It is believed that Lord Krishna and the Pandavas performed a "Golden Palli Yatra" here after their victory.

Distance: 15 km from C. M. Patel College of Nursing

Sachivalaya Gandhinagar

The administrative headquarters of the Government of Gujarat. The complex houses various government departments and offices and is an important center for state administration and governance. The area is well planned and reflects the organized infrastructure of Gandhinagar.

Distance: Approximately 4 km from C. M. Patel College of Nursing



Sarita Udhyan

A scenic riverside garden located along the banks of the Sabarmati River. The park is known for its lush green lawns, walking paths, and peaceful environment, making it a perfect place for relaxation and nature walks. Visitors can enjoy the calm surroundings and beautiful views of the river.
